2. Antiques should not be less than 50 years old.
3. No items previously receiving an award at this fair will be accepted for competition.
4. Mounted exhibits must be on firm backing and able to be hung on pegboard hooks.
5. All items must include a 3" X 5" card which tells the identity of article, age, place of origin and maker. Other interesting information such as use, family history, etc.
6. Reproductions will be disqualified.
7. Every precaution will be taken to ensure safety of exhibits, but in no case will the management be responsible for loss or injury to same.
8. The superintendent has the privilege of rejecting any item not meeting requirements.
