All exhibitors must be Meat Animal Quality Assurance (MAQA) certified to be eligible to show swine at the fair.

Stall rent of \$0.50 per animal will be charged, and collected on entry day.

Exhibitors will be responsible for furnishing feed and forage. Bedding will be supplied by the Fair, Inc.

Age classes:

Senior Spring Pig - farrowed January 1 to last day of Feb. of the exhibit year.

Junior Spring Pig - farrowed March 1 to June 30 of exhibit year.

Swine project members may also enter Department 110, Animal Science Projects, Class G.
