No exhibitor will be paid more than one premium under any one lot number and no article shall compete for more than one premium, except as part of a collection.

All honey and beeswax must be the product of bees owned by the exhibitor, and of the current season's production, except that granulated honey shall be of last season's production, or older.

Entries are entirely in charge of the superintendent, and are placed by him or his assistant. Entries in this class should not bear the name or trade-label of the owner, except in commercial exhibit.

In all cases where there is no competition, the matter of awards is left to the judge. No award will be made on poor specimens.
